Alice Capsey and Freya Kemp have earned their first call-ups to England Women's ODI squad for the Royal London Series against India.

A squad of 15 has been named for the three-match series, which will be England's first fixtures in the new ICC Women's Championship cycle, with points leading to qualification for the ICC Women's World Cup in 2025.

Amy Jones will continue to lead the side in the absence of Heather Knight
