ENGLAND MEN'S SQUADS NAMED FOR WHITE-BALL SERIES AGAINST WEST INDIES

The England Men's selection panel has named the squads for the upcoming white-ball series against the West Indies, set to begin later this month.

England, led by captain Harry Brook, will contest three Metro Bank One Day Internationals (ODIs) and three Vitality IT20s. The ODI series gets underway with the opening match on Thursday 29 May at Edgbaston.

Surrey batting all-rounder Will Jacks has been named in both squads, marking a return to the England set-up.
