Six uncapped players called up to Young Lions

England Men U19s have announced a squad with six uncapped players for the Youth One-Day Internationals against Ireland Men U19s and Bangladesh Men U19s.

Uncapped Will Bennison (Yorkshire), Jamie Feldman (Middlesex), Luke Hands (Lancashire), Joe Hawkins (Derbyshire), Manny Lumsden (Hampshire) and Jack Nelson (Middlesex) have been called into the 18-player squad.

Bennison scored a century when he captained a Young Lions Invitational XI

against India Men U19s at Loughborough in June - a match that Hands, Hawkins and Lumsden also played in.

Kent batter Ben Dawkins will captain the Young Lions for the first time in the one-off YODI against Ireland, before Thomas Rew is set to join the squad for the Bangladesh series.

Ben Mayes (Hampshire), Sebatian Morgan (Middlesex) and Rew (Somerset) are set to join the squad later in the week due to playing commitments with their respective Professional County Cricket Clubs.

Alex Green (Leicestershire) also features after an impressive Metro Bank One-Day Cup, during which his 18 wickets are the joint most in this year's men's competition.

Editor's Notes

The YODIs against Ireland Men U19s and Bangladesh Men U19s are the Young Lions last home fixtures ahead of the 2026 ICC Men U19s World Cup, will be staged in Zimbabwe and Namibia early next year.

The Young Lions are scheduled to play West Indies (five YODIs) and the United States (two YODIs) in the Caribbean during the winter as part of their lead-up. Both West Indies and USA have qualified for the 16-team World Cup.
