Murali Vijay requires 67 runs to reach 4000 in Tests. He will become the 16<sup>th</sup> Indian player to reach the mark.

Ajinkya Rahane requires 59 runs to reach 3000 in Tests. He will be the 22<sup>nd</sup> India player to do so.

Ishant Shama requires five wickets to reach 300 in Tests. He will be the sixth Indian player to do so.
