Winfield-Hill recalled to England Women IT20 squad

England Women have named squads for the ODI and IT20 series in West Indies, with Northern Diamonds opening batter Lauren Winfield-Hill recalled to the IT20 squad.

Captain Heather Knight is back after surgery on a hip injury, while allrounders Nat Sciver and Katherine Brunt both return having opted to take breaks from the game in the summer. The 19 players selected will travel out on November 29, with the four players not selected in the IT20 squad returning home at the end of the three-match ODI series.
